This is Mrs. Porcell with a few updates about our school closures:

- GUSD Schools are closed to students and staff from March 16-April 6th; As I receive updates, I will communicate these to you. There is always the possibility of extending school closures beyond April 6th and should this occur, you will be notified in a timely manner. Currently, we are enforcing a **Hard Closure**, which means no one on campus.
- We are working on compiling a list of resources for student use at home for maintaining skills. However, recommended assignments and resources shared are optional and WILL NOT be graded. Students will not be penalized for not utilizing resources as these are merely recommendations.
- School Grab & Go breakfasts and lunches are available at Stanton and Sellers Elementary Schools Monday-Friday from 9:00 a.m.-1:00 p.m. for all GUSD students. Please contact nutrition services if you would like for your child to participate in the Meal Program to ensure there are adequate meals for feeding all participants.
- Textbooks and accompanying resources are available online should your child wish to access these materials.
- All computer programs are available on our school website and students can access these using their district username and password. While students are encouraged to read, AR quizzes cannot be taken until school resumes.
- If you have student medication that you MUST retrieve immediately, please email me at mporcell@glendora.k12.ca.us so that we can arrange a time for a quick pick-up in the next two days.
- Please hold on to your See's Candy Orders. We are working on extending the date and will let you know as soon as possible.
- We are working on developing an extensive compilation of resources for student access at home that should be available on the GUSD portal sometime tomorrow. I will let you know when that is ready for viewing and downloading.
